Language paper 1: Explorations in creative reading and writing


Literature: Revision of Romeo and Juliet and A Christmas Carol



The Focus for this term is to explore how writer's use language and structure to produce effective narrative and descriptive writing. You will be focusing on Language paper 1 skills and practicing the skills you need in order to respond with confidence. We will begin by focusing on the reading section of the exam. We have attached video links as well as virtual lessons where you will learn how to respond to each question for section A of the paper. There is also a link to a full practice paper when you feel confident enough to have a go.

Section B of this paper focuses on your descriptive and narrative writing skills. Again. We have attached links to support you, including some atmospheric videos that you can play in the background and use to practice your narrative and descriptive writing skills.

Alongside this we would like you to revisit Romeo and Juliet and A Christmas Carol. We have attached video links to lessons to support your revision.
