Message from Headteacher

Last week, it was lovely to welcome so many parents to our year 11 parents evening and give them feedback as to how their children are performing in the run up to their GCSE exams. The hall was full for a solid three hours, with lots of focused conversation between teachers, students, parents and carers. Thank you to everyone who attended, we really appreciate the teamwork we have around your children.

Many of you will know that Miss Mills, Head of Year 11, left at Christmas. Since then, Miss J Coates has been simultaneously leading year 7 and 11. On Monday, Mr Copus joined our team from another local school. He has picked up the role of Head of Year 7, which will allow Miss J Coates to focus fully on Year 11 on the lead up to their exams.

Over the last two weeks, year 10 have completed their first set of GCSE style exams under exam board conditions. It has been wonderful to see them fully focus on the importance of these exams as part of their GCSE study and exam preparation. Well done year 10, you were brilliant!

This week, Mrs Crooks has led a mixed year group trip to Ullswater in the Lake District. The photos on social media show them having a wonderful time trying out a series of outdoor education activities. The weather forecast at the start of the week was horrendous, but it seems that it was far better than anticipated. They don't call it The Lake District for nothing!

In other news, under the leadership of Mr Clark, DHT we are delighted to tell you that we have been successful in our bid to acquire funding of over £135,000 through SHINE. SHINE is an education charity that works with teachers, schools, and other organisations, helping disadvantaged children in the North of England to fulfil their true potential. We will be working very closely with three primary head teachers at Barnes Juniors, Hudson Rd and Richard Avenue. We are collectively exploring the barriers to academic success for young people in the city by considering transition, community cohesion, literacy and hopefully the securing of consistent approaches amongst our team with teaching things such as reading. We will be looking to work with as many stakeholders as we can and as many community groups as we can to explore engagement in education.

Our new Arbor Parent and Guardian Portal has been launched, you should have received your log in details in your inbox.



We're using Arbor's free Parent Portal and Parent App



We've chosen Arbor to help us manage our school.

Arbor is a simple, smart and cloud-based MIS (Management Information System), which helps us work faster, smarter and more collaboratively as a school. The Parent App and Parent Portal mean we can keep you informed about your child's life at school in a much more accessible way. Log into Arbor to see and update your child's information, get live updates and make payments or bookings on the go!

The Parent Portal works on Google Chrome (computer or laptop) and you can download the Parent App from the App Store or Google Play Store on your phone (Android 5.0; iOS 10.0 and upwards).

How to get started

1. Wait for your welcome email from us telling you Arbor is ready - you won't be able to log in before
2. Click the link in your welcome email to set up your password
3. Go to the App or Google Play Store on your phone and search 'Arbor'
4. Click 'Install' on Android or 'Get' on iPhone then open the App
5. Enter your email, select the school, then enter your password
6. Accept the Terms & Conditions and enter your child's birthday

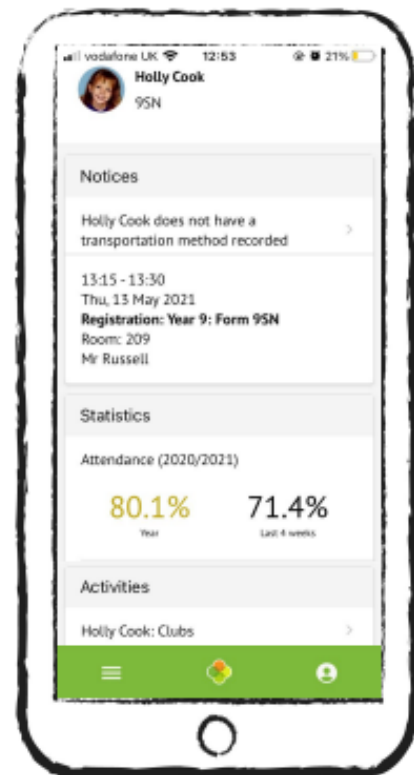
Need help using Arbor?

Contact the school office if you have questions about Arbor, the App or Parent Portal. Tell us the type and model of your phone, e.g. an iPhone SE, and include screenshots or screen recordings.

To safeguard student data in line with General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), Arbor only works directly with schools.

Some tips to try:

1. Ensure your username is the email address you use for Arbor. Ask us to **check the email address** linked to your account.
2. **Reset your password** from the login page, or ask us to do this.
3. If the login email was sent to you more than 96 hours ago, the **password link will have expired**. Ask us to send it again.
4. Ask the school office to check that your email address has not been used twice - e.g. on another guardian or child's profile.
5. **Enter the birthday** of one of your children to log in.
6. Only relatives who are **Primary Guardians** of a child can access the Arbor App. Ask us to check you can access Arbor.

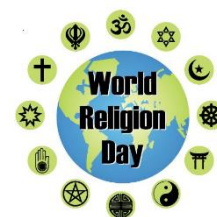
Our final morning at Ullswater. A lovely walk to a beautiful waterfall and a chance to get in touch with nature. All children have been superstars this week, we are so proud of them.
