Dear Pupils, Parents and Carers,

Whilst this academic year has seen great disruption to our year 10 cohort, we have seen some excellent attitudes and resilience from our year 10 pupils. We acknowledge that this has been particularly hard for year 10 as they have only just embarked on their Key Stage 4 and GCSE courses.
