Thank you for your fantastic support and cooperation during the situation on Friday 2nd July, when we were made aware of a positive COVID-19 test amongst our staff body.

We will be working over the weekend to mitigate any further disruption to your child's learning at Thornhill Academy.

Our plan currently involves Years 7 and 10 to attend school on Monday the 5th of July as normal. Students will receive a blend of both face to face learning and remote access learning within the school building.

Years 8 and 9 will remain at home and access their normal timetable via our remote learning platform Class-Charts.

We intend to have normal school operation as of Monday the 12th of July with all staff and students.


Following advice from public health, we encourage all students to self-test with the lateral flow tests provided previously. There is no need to self-isolate unless you are directly informed of your child's need to do this.
