RE: Year 11 and their final weeks

I hope you are well. I am writing to remind you that school continues as normal for your child, with the final full-cohort exam scheduled for **15 June 2026**. Your child will be taught until this point and they are expected to be in school.

Your child will have a bespoke timetable for the next two weeks. Over the course of the year, we have carefully monitored your child's progress and used question-level analysis to identify areas where they need further support. Our current sessions are designed specifically to address these gaps, and this targeted teaching cannot be replaced by revision at home.

Towards the end of this week, I will send further details about your child's final day in school. For now, I want to be clear that we expect all students to attend, follow their personalised timetable, and continue learning with our expert staff. They will have a long summer break ahead, and your support in maintaining attendance during this crucial period is greatly appreciated. We are teaching purposefully to ensure they get the highest grades possible.

I will also write soon with information about the leavers' assembly, where students will have the chance to sign shirts and celebrate together. Attendance over the next two weeks will be required for students to take part in this final celebration.

When the date of the leavers' service is confirmed, please send your child in with any school-issued revision guides so we can use them in planning for Year 10. If you have any uniform items in good condition that you no longer need, we would be very grateful for donations to our spare-uniform collection- this can be brought in to the celebration assembly or dropped at reception.
