



Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find outlined below the arrangements for your child's dismissal following their final examinations.

The final examination for the full cohort will take place on the morning of **15th June 2026**. Students will be dismissed from the school site immediately after completing their exam. The exam is scheduled to begin at **9:00 am** and will last:

- **1 hour 15 minutes** for students studying **Combined Science**
- **1 hour 45 minutes** for students studying **Separate Sciences**

Students will be dismissed as soon as they have completed their exam. Those entitled to additional time will receive it and will be dismissed at the end of their allocated exam duration.

The only exception to this is for students sitting the **Further Mathematics GCSE** in the afternoon. These students are required to remain on site, attend a booster session, and sit their examination, which begins at **1:30 pm** and lasts **1 hour 45 minutes** they will be dismissed immediately after that examination.

Please note that dismissal times may vary slightly depending on the exact timing and flow of the examinations.

Students who continue to positively engage in school over the next two weeks will be invited back on **25th June 2026**, from **12:35 pm to 1:35 pm**, for a final farewell and celebration assembly with staff. This will provide an opportunity for shirt signing and photographs.

Students should report to **reception**, and the celebration will take place in the **Small Hall**. Any revision guides or spare uniform may either be returned during this event or dropped off at reception at any convenient time and will be received with great appreciation.

I would like to thank you for your continued support throughout this academic year. The students have been a credit to themselves, and I am confident that we will celebrate another year of record-breaking results for students of Thornhill Academy.
