**Re: Examination Results Day – Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021**

We are pleased to be able to invite our Year 11 pupils into school on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August** between **10am and 12 noon** to collect their GCSE results.

We will continue to take precautions to reduce risk of COVID-19 infection. We ask that pupils enter the school building via the main reception and results will be available to be collected from the main hall. Pupils can then follow the one way system and meet with friends and family on the yard.

A number of school staff will be available on results day to help deal with any queries that pupils may have along with a representative from Career Wave so that we can support you to access your next steps in Education, Employment and Training.

If a pupil is unable to attend and wishes for another family member to collect their results, they must bring with them a form of identification along with a letter signed by the pupil giving their permission for results to be issued. Any results not collected on results day will be available for collection from reception. If results need to be posted, please contact the school.
