STUDY STARS



This is a 'study star' made to help pupils revise work for an upcoming science exam. This is an interesting and useful way of revising a lot of written information!

The 4 pointed star has 3 'pages' per point giving 12 spaces to order and organize all the facts needed. It's easily transported too so they can do a quick cram on the way to the exam :)

To make your own study star simple cut 2 large squares the same size and one smaller (cut more squares for more pages/flaps.) Fold the corners of the square into the middle so the points touch. Repeat with all the layers and glue JUST the back of each square (when unfolded it's easy to see the fold lines that make a square) onto the front of the square behind it...

Write the details and personalise it last, you will be surprised how much information these study stars will hold!
