We are delighted to inform you that we are launching the student leadership programme for all year 9s this half term.

The student leadership programme is designed to give all Key Stage 4 students an opportunity to develop their life skills, leadership qualities, confidence, and problem-solving by becoming an extension of specific departments in school. As a student leader, your child has the opportunity to be part of the department and subject structure, working alongside staff to develop our school community.

As a student leader, your child will be given the opportunity to wear a bespoke school uniform, which allows them to not only have status within the school, but also be used as a reference point for each subject. Student leaders will be heavily involved in the planning, organisation, and operational aspects of the wider curriculum commitment from each department.
