We are delighted to welcome your child to join us in September. At Thornhill we pride ourselves with high standards and expectation for all our students.

THORNHILL ACADEMY UNIFORM

The uniform at Thornhill Academy is intended to be fit for purpose in an educational setting. It helps students present themselves positively, gives them confidence to represent the academy and promotes a strong sense of identity. The details of both the academy and PE uniforms are given below.

Students are expected to wear correct uniform throughout the school year. Items which students grow out of or require replacing, must be replaced as and when necessary and not just at the start of the school year.

The items of the academy and PE uniform which are indicated below are purchased directly from Little Gems or a High Street alternative.

	Guidance
Black Blazer Embroidered (new school logo)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Replacement of the blazer with an alternative jacket, hoody or tracksuit top is not allowed.
Formal White School Shirt - to be tucked in	<ul style="list-style-type: none">This is not a polo shirt.
School Maroon and Silver Striped Clip-on tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The tie must be worn at all times.
Black V Neck Jumper	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The jumper is an optional item. Students can choose whether or not to wear the jumper under their blazer.This can be purchased from any High Street provider.School embroidered jumpers are not compulsory.Round neck sweatshirts are not an alternative.The wearing of the jumper does not replace the wearing of the blazer.
Black School Shoes – Leather type	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Footwear must be 100% black with no logos.No trainers.No canvas material.
Dark Coloured Waterproof Coat	<ul style="list-style-type: none">No hoodies, tracksuit tops, sweatshirts, denim jackets.Not to be worn under the blazer.Not to be worn inside of the building.

Black Tights	Or Black/White Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No patterned tights.
Formal Black Trouser or	Black Charleston Skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Skirts must be a Black Charleston style skirt with a flat upper section and pleated lower section. Short 'tube' type designs are not acceptable. Trousers must not be denim, jeans or jean style. No leggings are allowed.
Important information to also note:		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No excessive or heavy make-up. Short, neutral-coloured nails only. Baseball caps are banned, and other hats/hoods must not be worn inside the buildings. Jewellery which can be worn, is a single pair of stud earrings and a wristwatch. No extreme haircuts, lines, or shading. Mobile phones are not permitted and will be confiscated if seen or heard.

Navy Blue Polo Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School embroidered items are not compulsory.
Navy Tracksuit Bottoms or Navy Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School embroidered items are not compulsory.
Navy or Black Leggings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must not be worn as part of the regular school uniform.
Football Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy football socks
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be sports trainers. Football boots and shin pads may be required at times.
Important information to also note:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long hair must be tied up. All jewellery must be removed. PE Kit is not optional. It is an essential requirement as part of the curriculum.
