

Dear Parents/ Carers,

As we have approached the start of a new half term, we would like to ensure that we have the highest possible standards and expectations for all of our young people. As the academy continues to improve, there are some key areas which we need to address, to ensure every child gets the best education possible. As we return to school, I would like to thank you for your continued support and would like to remind you of the following standards expected from students here at Thornhill Academy.

Uniform

The large majority of students wear their uniform with pride and attend school in the correct school uniform. Our policy is available online. We expect the following from all of our students:

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Dark coloured Wat	erproof Coat (ONLY)	 No hoodies, tracksuit tops, sweatshirts, denim jackets. Not to be worn under the blazer. Not to be worn inside of the building. Non-uniform items will be confiscated.
Black Tights	or Black/White Socks	No patterned tights.
Formal Black Trousers	or Black Charleston skirt	 Skirts must be a Black Charleston style skirt with a flat upper section and pleated lower section. Short 'tube' type designs are not acceptable. Trousers must not be denim, jeans, or jean style. No leggings are allowed.
Important informa	tion to also note:	 No excessive or heavy make-up. Short, neutral-coloured nails only. Baseball caps are banned, and other hats/hoods must not be worn inside the buildings. Jewellery which can be worn, is a single pair of stud earrings and a wristwatch. No extreme haircuts, lines, or shading. Mobile phones are not permitted and will be confiscated if seen or heard.

Loan uniform will be offered where possible, or parent will be contacted to bring items into school to support students, to remedy any issues they may have. Where issues can't be resolved the student will be placed in isolation until the issue is resolved.

Mobile telephones

Mobile telephones should not be used during the academy day, as students should be focused on their learning during lessons. We encourage our young people to speak to their peers during social times and do not believe using a mobile supports this. Any student with a mobile

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telephone, or earphones, will be confiscated until the end of the school day, we understand that, at times, children may need to contact home, our pastoral team will support your child in contacting home if needed.

Breach of expectations

If a student does not follow these expectations, then parents will be contacted, and the student will be placed in isolation until the issue is resolved.
